Within the "Investments for the Future" programme launched by the French government, the University of Bordeaux has been awarded a number of initiatives in recognition of its innovative training, research and knowledge transfer programmes.

- › Nearly **700 partner universities** based in over **80 countries**.
- › Dedicated exchange programmes with more than **60 countries** worldwide.
- › Strategic partners in **3 continents** of the world: Asia, Europe and North America, as well as one Euroregional campus, Bordeaux-Euskampus.
- › Member of **ENLIGHT, a European University for societal engagement** selected by Erasmus+. This consortium aims to contribute to the transformation of European higher education.

Education, a multidisciplinary offer



- › **52,000** students (14% international).
- › College of Law, Political Science, Economics, Management / College of Health Sciences / College of Human Sciences / College of Science and Technology / Institute of Technology / Institute of Education / Institute of Vine and Wine Science.
- › **245** national degrees, from vocational to doctoral level.
- › Unique fields of expertise, e.g. our national diploma in wine science.



A multitude of international study possibilities

- › Approx. **70 international study programmes** at every level (Bachelor, Master, PhD) with over **30** double degrees.
- › **30 Master** programmes taught **100% in English**.
- › **19 EU-labeled programmes of excellence**, including 7 Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees.
- › **1,500 students** each year with credit mobility (incoming/outgoing).
- › Over **7,200 international students** (> 150 different nationalities).

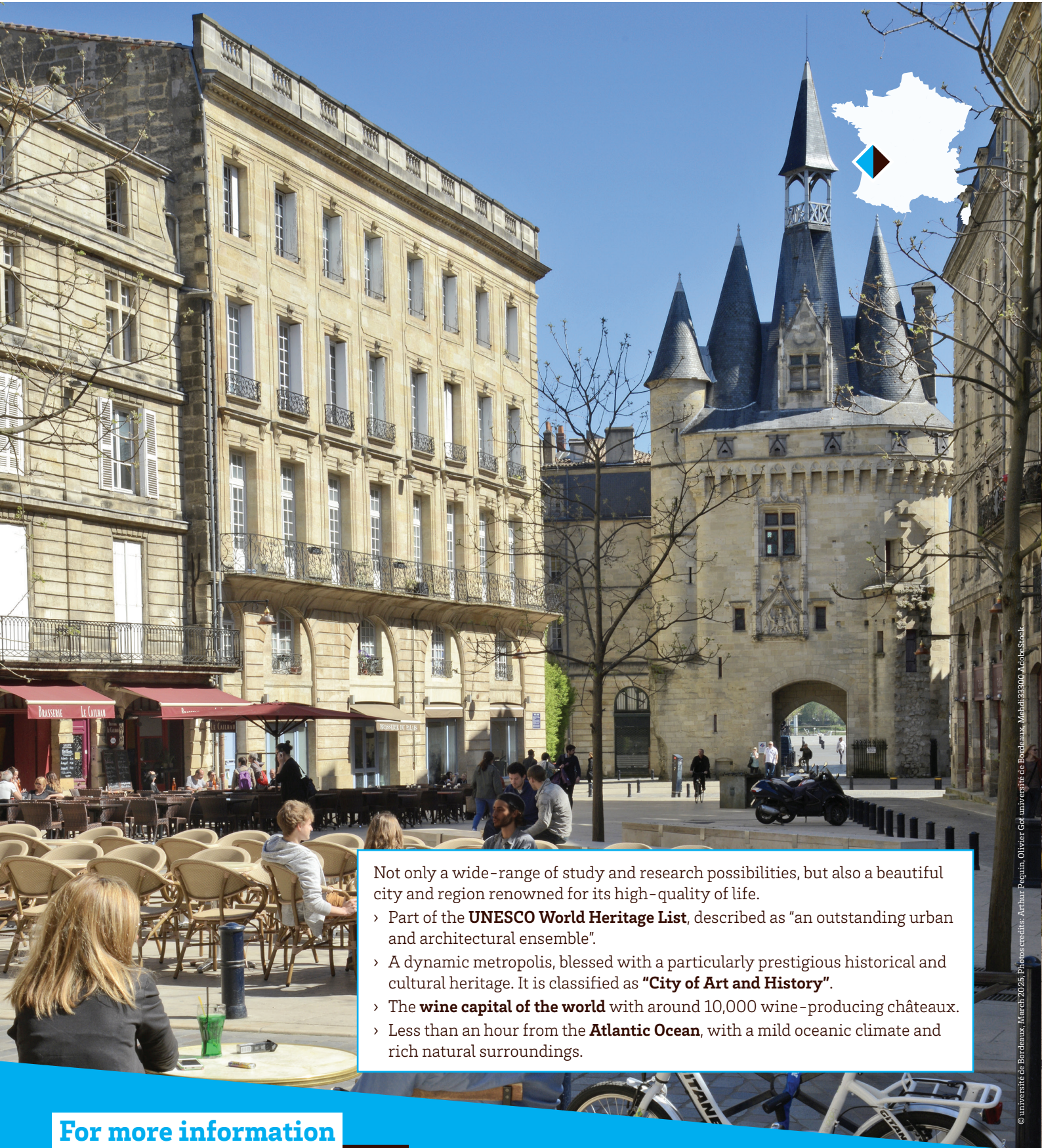
Research, our driving force

- › **11 multidisciplinary research departments:** Social sciences of contemporary changes / Behaviour, organisations and policy evaluation / Law and social transformations / Bordeaux Neurocampus / Biological and medical sciences / Public health / Health sciences and technologies / Environmental sciences / Engineering and digital sciences / Material and light sciences / Archaeological sciences.
- › **7 Major Research Programmes:** BPS - Bordeaux Plant Sciences / BRAIN_2030 - Bordeaux Region Aquitaine Initiative for the future of Neuroscience / HOPE - Understanding Human Well-being and Behaviour for better Policies & Societies / Human Past / IPORA - Interdisciplinary Policy-Oriented Research on Africa / LIGHT - Light science and its applications / PPM - Post-Petroleum Materials.
- › **Approx. 10 Bordeaux Summer Schools** for postgraduate scholars each year.
- › **Two University Hospital Institutes** in the fields of cardiology and vascular brain health
- › **82** research laboratories.
- › A **Graduate Research School: 2,000** PhD students, **8** Doctoral Schools and several Graduate Research Programmes (e.g. within the domains of neuroscience, digital public health, light sciences and technologies, complex digital systems, advanced chemistry, cancer biology and cardiac electrophysiology).
- › Strong partnerships with national research institutes (CNRS, Inserm, INRAE, INRIA, CEA, etc.).



A hub of international, cutting edge research

- › **22 international joint research laboratories, 8 cross-border joint laboratories**, as well as **an international joint research unit**.
- › Over **200 EU collaborative projects** (Horizon Europe, H2020, FP7 & Interreg).
- › **5** projects awarded a **European Research Council** grant (ongoing in 2024).
- › **150** joint **PhD** agreements.
- › A **Welcome Centre** for International Researchers (including PhD students) that welcomes and supports over 800 international researchers (representing 70 different nationalities) with administration, accommodation, social and cultural integration services.



Not only a wide-range of study and research possibilities, but also a beautiful city and region renowned for its high-quality of life.

- › Part of the **UNESCO World Heritage List**, described as "an outstanding urban and architectural ensemble".
- › A dynamic metropolis, blessed with a particularly prestigious historical and cultural heritage. It is classified as "**City of Art and History**".
- › The **wine capital of the world** with around 10,000 wine-producing châteaux.
- › Less than an hour from the **Atlantic Ocean**, with a mild oceanic climate and rich natural surroundings.
